Who can apply?

Anyone working in the water industry who is a member of the IWA or whose organisation is a corporate member of the IWA. You must have your employer's support and endorsement to apply.

Your project must:

- Be relevant to your current position or career development;
- Develop associations or alliances that are of strategic importance to the water industry, the IWA and you;
- Benefit you, the water industry and the IWA.

The IWA encourages sharing of information across the industry, if you are the recipient of the award you gain the opportunity to share your findings at an IWA Conference.

The award grant can be used for travel costs, living expenses and other costs associated with the project or activity. It cannot be used to support study for formal qualifications.
